The project

Objectives

The project has the ambition to equip students with key skills that can complement the hard skills gained during their respective degrees and create a mass of citizens equipped with the skills demanded by the job market and foster critical thinking, innovation, and entrepreneurship in young people.

The OUT-DOOR project seeks to implement an innovative teaching approach based on two pillars:

- To seek the complementarity and interconnectivity among different European Education Frameworks named LifeComp, DigComp and GreenComp.
- To train and certify skills gained during outdoors activities, using IT tools and evaluation grids and using microcredentials.
